Secretary General of the Central Commission for the Navigation of the Rhine

After studying law in Brussels and Cambridge Bruno Georges practised as a lawyer in Brussels from 1979 to 1986, and was thereafter employed in the civil service with the United Nations in Kigali (Ruanda) and in Bujumbura (Burundi) until 1988. Mr Georges entered the Belgian diplomatic service in 1989. Throughout his career he gained experience in various embassies, for example as First Secretary at the Embassy in Berlin and Bonn and as Consul General in Shanghai, and in both the Belgian Foreign Ministry and the Permanent Representation to the European Union. Mr Georges served as a member of the diplomatic corps with the OSCE as Ambassador and Permanent Representative until August 2016. Bruno Georges succeeded to the office of Secretary General of the CCNR on 1 November 2016.
